

Supplemental Educational Services Notification

As a result of the federal *No Child Left Behind* Act, your child had the option to receive extra help in the areas of reading and/or mathematics through the Supplemental Educational Services (SES). Your child was able to receive this free tutoring service if the school they attended was in its second year or later of school improvement and your family met the federal income eligibility requirements.

Each year a list of approved providers who have agreed to serve Joliet Public Schools - District 86 with Supplementary Educational Services (SES) is enclosed in a registration packet and mailed home to eligible families.

In 2007-2008 Supplemental Educational Services (SES) was offered to over 2,500 eligible families (free/reduce lunch). Approximately 680 students took advantage of the tutoring services provided on-site at A.O. Marshall Elementary, Dirksen Jr. High, Gompers Jr. High, Hufford Jr. High, and Washington Jr. High.

During the 2008-2009 school year Supplemental Educational Services (SES) was again offered to over 2,500 eligible families (free/reduce lunch). Three hundred and twenty five students enrolled in the tutoring services provide on-site and on-line at A.O. Marshall Elementary, Dirksen Jr. High, Gompers Jr. High, Hufford Jr. High, and Washington Jr. High.

In 2009-2010 Supplemental Educational Services (SES) was offered to over 3,000 eligible families at A.O. Marshall Elementary, Edna Keith Elementary, Lynne Thigpen Elementary, M. J. Cunningham Elementary, Dirksen Jr. High, Gompers Jr. High, Hufford Jr. High, and Washington Jr. High. Over 400 students enrolled in the after-school tutoring provided by on-site or on-line tutoring.

The 2010-2011 Supplemental Educational Services (SES) registration packets were mailed to over 3,500 eligible families from the following schools: A.O. Marshall Elementary, Edna Keith Elementary, Lynne Thigpen Elementary, M.J. Cunningham Elementary, Woodland Elementary, Gompers Jr. High, Hufford Jr. High, and Washington Jr. High.
