

## **2012 Spring Soccer Information**



### **Please Read Carefully**

The 2012 Spring Soccer season is on its way, so register your child now.
All participants will enjoy the thrill of soccer competition!

- Copy of Birth Certificate must accompany registration form if you haven't already done so.
- **Uniforms** Participants receive a team jersey and matching socks that they will keep at the end of the season. Parents provide black shorts and mandatory shin guards. Children may play in tennis shoes or soccer shoes. **No Baseball Shoes Allowed. Uniforms must be worn in all games.**
- Rosters Roster sizes are limited to allow maximum playing time for all participants.
- **Team Selection** Players are selected for co-recreational teams through a draft. Siblings in same age group are placed together. **OTHER SPECIAL REQUESTS MAY BE NOTED ON THE REGISTRATION FORM.**
- Awards All players will receive a trophy or other award.
- NO REFUNDS OR CREDITS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER DEADLINE.
- THIS IS A RECREATIONAL SOCCER LEAGUE.

**Registration is currently underway. A deadline of February 27, 2012** is necessary in order for uniforms to be delivered on a timely basis. A late fee of \$10 per player will be imposed for registrations after February 27, 2012. Players may register in person at the Multi-Purpose Center or Inwood Athletic Club or also by mail.

Resident Discount Cards are mandatory for all Joliet Park District residents, 6 years and older, who wish to take advantage of resident rates. When **applying for/renewing** your Resident Discount Card you must bring each of the following:

- Current Resident Discount Card (if applicable)
- (1) form of picture I.D.
- A current property tax or utility bill showing your name and address
