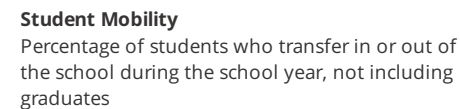
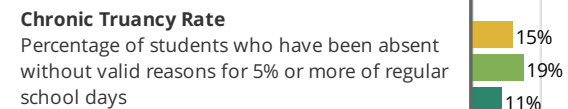
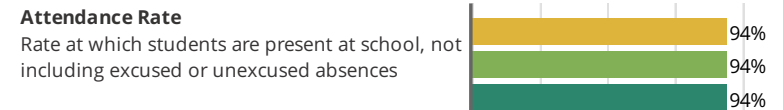
School Environment
