


Girls working with computers to create cool things.

Girls Create with Technology is designed to engage girls in computer science and STEM activities. Girls participating in the program will receive advanced training in various aspects of Computer Science from Lewis University faculty and students. Along with a summer camp (4 days, 9am-2pm), we offer Maker Sessions during the school year. These classes are held from 9:00am-12:00pm. We will meet in the Computer Science labs located in the Science Center on the main campus of Lewis University. They are designed for girls in 6th through 10th grade and each session will focus on using technology to design and create a certain type of object. No experience is necessary.

Girls may attend any or all of the classes, but they must register for each session separately.

Our next Maker Sessions is Saturday, Dec 1, 2018 from 9:00am-12:00pm.
