The <u>Every Kid Outdoors</u> program is designed for 4<sup>th</sup> grade students to visit and learn about federal land and water sites. As a 4th grader with a pass, anyone in the vehicle with you is admitted for free to sites that charge per vehicle. ## How to get the Every Kid Outdoors 4th grade interagency annual pass

- Go to website: everykidinapark.gov/get-your-pass/
- Click on Get Your Pass
- Click on Parents or Educators
- Follow instructions for parent or educator
- Print out the special bar coded paper pass/voucher. It loods like this
- Call Midewin National Tallgrass Prairie (815)423-6370 to see if they have the durable plastic card passes on hand & also that a collection officer is present to conduct the transaction
- Take your 4<sup>th</sup> grade student, take the coded paper pass/voucher to *Midewin*National Tallgrass Prairie or another site from this list: <a href="https://store.usgs.gov/s3fs-public/PassIssuanceList.pdf">https://store.usgs.gov/s3fs-public/PassIssuanceList.pdf</a>
- Student <u>must be present</u> to sign this free, yearlong pass (valid from Sept.1-Aug.31 of 4<sup>th</sup> grade year)
- The 4<sup>th</sup> grade student must be present to use the pass at federal land & water sites
