Applications for all grades will be taken from January through March. Students must demonstrate achievement at or above grade level in order to enroll and remain in the Washington Junior High & Academy program. Students must exhibit positive behavior along with maintaining good academic standing.


The number of openings per grade level varies by year. Teacher recommendation, achievement test scores, and report cards are used to determine the eligibility of students. Notification letters indicating your child's status will be mailed in June or later, depending on when openings become available.

In order to ensure academic excellence, specific standards are maintained. These include general entrance requirements, high achievement, positive behavior, regular on-time attendance, homework completion, academic honesty, and fulfilling the four way learning agreement.

Parental involvement is a key component of the **Washington Junior High School Academy Program**. Parents must agree to support the school's philosophy by attending **at least four mandatory parent sessions** in addition to Parent/ Teacher Conferences. Numerous parenting sessions are offered throughout the year on various topics. The mandatory Open House counts as the first parent session; parents are required to attend three additional sessions of their choice. Unless otherwise specified, children may NOT attend parent sessions. Make-up sessions will not be offered. Please note **that failure to fulfill these obligations may result in dismissal** from the Washington Junior High School Academy Program.

El personal de la Escuela Washington Junior High y Academia cree en la promoción de un entorno educativo estructurado. Creemos en enfatizar la responsabilidad académica y conductual junto con la promoción de la autoestima positiva en todos nuestros niños.

Las solicitudes para todos los grados se tomarán de Enero a Marzo. Las cartas de notificación que indican el estado de su hijo(a) se enviarán por correo en junio o más tarde, dependiendo de cuándo estén disponibles las vacantes.

Para garantizar la excelencia académica, se mantienen estándares específicos. Estos incluyen requisitos generales de ingreso, alto rendimiento, comportamiento positivo, asistencia regular a tiempo, finalización de la tarea, honestidad académica y cumplimiento del acuerdo de aprendizaje de cuatro vías.

La participación de los padres es un componente clave del **Programa de la Escuela Washington High y Academia**. Los padres deben aceptar apoyar la filosofía de la escuela asistiendo **al menos a cuatro sesiones obligatorias para padres** además de las conferencias de padres y maestros. Numerosas sesiones de crianza se ofrecen durante todo el año en varios temas. El Open House es obligatorio y cuenta como la primera sesión principal; los padres deben asistir a tres sesiones adicionales de su elección. A menos que se especifique lo contrario, los niño(a)s **NO** pueden asistir a las sesiones de padres. No se ofrecerán sesiones por segunda vez. Admission and Registration Requirement

Applications for incoming students will be taken from January through March. Applications are used for the following school year only. If a student is not accepted, a new application should be requested for the next school year.

A parent must contact the school office for an application packet. The application and all requirements must be completed and returned to the school office prior to March 20, 2020 of the preceding school year.

In addition to the completed application the following items must be returned as well:

- IAR Test scores for the most recent school year
- STAR Test Record Report using the PARCC scale for Reading & Math showing minimum scale scores of:
 - Math- 708; Reading-663 (incoming 6th grade)
 - Math- 764; Reading-777 (incoming 7th grade)
 - Math- 793; Reading-830 (incoming 8th grade)
- Current Report Card
- Two teacher recommendation forms from a previous teacher (forms attached)
- Writing Prompt: In a 500 word, typed essay answer the following:
 - Describe a topic, idea, or concept you find so engaging that it makes you lose all track of time. Why does it captivate you? What or who do you turn to when you want to learn more?
- Parent Survey

ALL of the above must be included for a student to be considered. Application **MUST** be filled out in its entirety and all requested documents present in order to be considered.

The Academy Program considers students for admission who demonstrate grade level or above skills along with positive conduct. All students are considered on an individual basis. Once the application packet and proper information have been received, the Washington administration, along with a selection committee will select the applicants for admission.

Notification letters indicating the child's acceptance status to the Academy will be mailed in early June. Siblings of students applying to or currently attending the Academy are not automatically accepted into the program. Applications are held for one year only. If a student is not accepted, then the application process must start over for the next school year.
