




Cub Scout Pack 26

We are a Family Pack for both boys and girls ages 5 (or entering kindergarten) through 10 (or entering 5th grade). Cub Scouting is a parent volunteer run program that combines fun with educational activities and lifelong values.

What do we do?

In Cub Scouting, you and your family join in on the program with your child, and you will help them along the way. Cub Scouts have a different handbook at each grade level, with adventures that are age-appropriate for their developmental level. As your child advances



through these books by working on adventures, they will earn badges and other recognition that they wear on their uniform. As your child grows in Cub Scouting, your role will change with them, from hands-on involvement to guiding and coaching. Your child's success in Cub Scouting depends on you! The Cub Scouting program takes place at two levels. Your child will be a part of a den, a small group of Cub Scouts in the same grade level and who are of the same gender. A den typically meets twice a month, although some may meet more often. All dens, from kindergarten through fifth grade, make up a pack. Once a month, the dens, with their families, come together at the pack meeting and Cub Scouts are recognized for the adventures and badges they have earned.

When and Where?

Dens meet at St. Raymond, at the Den Leader's home and/or at a location chosen for a special adventure.



Pack meetings are held at St Raymond or at a location chosen for a special adventure. Typically, Dens meet the first and third Friday of the month, and the Pack meetings are the fourth Saturday of the month.
