2021 PROGRAMS - OPEN REGISTRATION

ATHLETIC SPORTS CAMPS

Held at Central and West, summer offerings include camps for all grade levels from elementary to high school. Spots are filled on a first come, first served basis.

TRIO

TRIO is offering a free summer program to JTHS high school students of all ages, including incoming freshmen and graduating seniors. The three-week program begins June 7 and includes topics such as college readiness, financial literacy, career exploration and much more. The TRIO Summer Bridge also includes free meals, a free t-shirt as well as fun educational field trips. Students will receive up to \$180 for program participation. Participants must be registered for TRIO and must complete a Summer Bridge application by May 25.

NAWIC SUMMER CONSTRUCTION CAMP FOR JTHS HIGH SCHOOL GIRLS OF ALL AGES

A free summer camp is available to JTHS high school girls of all ages interested in the construction industry. The camp takes place in-person at Joliet Central High School from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. June 21-24. Transportation is provided to the student's home campus and students from all JTHS campuses are invited to attend. The camp is facilitated by NAWIC (National Association of Women in Construction) and includes hands-on activities, access to architects and engineers, and more.

SUMMER SCHOOL ADVANCEMENT

Summer school (advancement) is a program offered to all students who seek to take additional classes in order to advance their learning and open their school year schedule. Offered hybrid and online, depending on the course.

SUMMER SCHOOL RECOVERY

Summer School Recovery is a program offered to all students who have failed a core class required for graduation. The goal of the program is to get students back on track for graduation. Students can enroll in multiple core classes during the summer. Students will focus on key learning objectives to recover the credit from the class. Students will earn a Pass/ Fail on their transcript.

DRIVER EDUCATION (AFTER/SUMMER SCHOOL)

Students must start the process to register for all sessions by completing a "Permit To Enroll" form and verifying they qualify to enroll. After students are verified, the registration fee will be added to student accounts.

SUMMER SCHOOL (INVITATION ONLY)

SUMMER BRIDGE FOR INCOMING FRESHMEN

For incoming freshmen enrolled in math and literacy support, Summer Bridge is a series of weeklong day camps designed to expose high school students to an array different courses from baking and pastries, automotive, and more.

SUMMER APEX

Summer school for Special Education and Pathways Students.

SPECIAL EDUCATION ENRICHMENT RECOVERY PROGRAM

This first of a kind summer enrichment opportunity will focus on academic skills in reading, math, and writing in an engaging environment infused with SEL, vocational, and team-building activities. These activities will potentially identify and target learning gaps that may have been attributed to or inflated by remote learning.

EXTENDED SCHOOL YEAR FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION STUDENTS

Provides a continuation of services to identified special education students who were negatively impacted by remote learning.

CLASS OF 2025 SUMMER AP/HONORS PROGRAM

Provides an overview of the AP/honors classes and engages students into our high school environment.
